

## About The Stand-Alone Mayan Jungle Adventure Glossary

To use the glossary, open **[glossary.html](#)** in any web browser. You do not need an active web connection. Click the speaker icon or the informal phonetic spelling of a word to hear it pronounced.

If you are using **Mayan Jungle Adventure** in one of the multimedia applications (Classroom Suite, HyperStudio, Clicker) the entire glossary entry, the word and its definition, will read aloud, using whatever voice is currently set for the system voice of the computer. However, there is great variation in pronunciation with computer text to speech, even between different voices on the same computer.

For this reason, I thought it worth while to set up this separate stand alone glossary so that students could hear all these words pronounced correctly. If you are using the online or desktop version of **Mayan Jungle Adventure**, the glossary is accessible from each page, but you still may find this stand-alone glossary helpful for writing in the journals. The pronunciations you hear in the online version and the stand alone version are identical.
