

Printable Puzzles

The PDF files in this folder are jigsaw puzzles made from photos in the Pablo Pelican activity set.

There are either 9 or 11 pieces in these puzzles.

Using The Puzzles

1. For each puzzle, print out the page using US letter size paper in landscape orientation. If you use photo paper, the colors of the puzzle will be richer.
2. Mount the puzzle sheet on some type of stiff backing (cardboard, flexible plastic, etc).
3. Carefully cut around each puzzle piece. Don't worry if you waver a little. The puzzle pieces will still fit together.
4. You may wish to coat the pieces with a clear layer to make them more durable. Be sure to test to make sure the ink does not run. Also be sure that the coating is safe for kids.
