

Printable Puzzles

Each of the three PDF files in this folder is a jigsaw puzzle made from one of the photos from Visiting A Petting Farm. There are nine pieces in each puzzle.

1. Print out a page using standard letter size paper in portrait orientation. If you use photo paper, the colors of the puzzle will be richer.
2. Mount a puzzle sheet on some type of stiff backing (cardboard, flexible plastic, etc).
3. Carefully cut out each puzzle piece. There will be some solid colored scraps, as the pieces are not touching on the printed sheet.
4. You may wish to coat the pieces with a clear layer to make them more durable. Be sure to test to make sure the ink does not run. Also be sure that the coating is safe for kids.

These puzzles were created with the Puzzle Maker stack. You can download this stack from the Annie's Resource Attic site. Run it on either the full or player version of HyperStudio 5, create your puzzle, and make a screen shot for a printable puzzle.
