Showertime! Sequence Activity

The following pages have the steps for getting ready to take a shower. Each page has three steps, each including the text and the same graphic as the button for that step in the Showertime! story. Cut each page into three strips to use in off-computer sequence activities. Individual strips can be cut in two to use for matching games. Mount pages on cardboard or foam core before cutting. Hook and loop tape can be glued to the back of each strip to use on a felt board.



Put a bar of soap into the dish.




Put the shampoo bottle onto the shelf.



Hang the back brush on the peg.




Hang the washcloth on the small rack.

Make a custom fill pattern in PhotoShop® with these tiles! In PhotoShop, open this PDF and choose page 4 to open this page. Select the tiles with the Rectangular Marquee, with some white around them. Use Magic Wand set to Subtract to remove the white border. Under Edit, choose Define Pattern... and give your custom fill a name.

To use your custom fill, select a fairly big area, because the tiles are 500 pixels square. Under Edit, choose Fill, and set for Pattern. Choose your custom tile pattern, and click OK.
